Coach Job Description

The Ontario Hockey Federation (OHF) is now accepting applications for coaching positions at the 2012 OHF/OHL Under-16 Program of Excellence.

- There will be a minimum of one OHF coach per team.
- OHF coaches will work with Ontario Hockey League (OHL) personnel.
- Must be present for the entire duration of the program and are required to stay in the same accommodations as staff and players.
- Coaches, in conjunction with other staff must assist in holding players to high standards with respect to behavior both on and off the ice.

Duties

- Coordinate and conduct all on and off ice training sessions in conjunction with team staff.
- Assist with the designing of team practice plans if necessary.
- Coach team in all games and practices.
- Conduct team building exercises or activities with players as necessary during downtime.
- Coordinate with team staff the supervision and transporting of players.

Qualifications

- Strong hockey background in coaching.
- Ability to work well with other personnel including coaches, trainers and support staff.
- Must have strong interpersonal skills in order to communicate with staff, coaches, players, parents and medical personnel.
- Must be NCCP certified and Speak Out (or Respect In Sport) certified.
- Must have coached a team within the OHF in 2011-12 or be coaching a team within the OHF in 2012-13.
