Coach Job Description

The Ontario Hockey Federation (OHF) is now accepting applications for coaching positions at the 2009 OHF/OHL Under-16 Program of Excellence.

- There are six positions available at each camp (one per team).
- Each OHF Member Partner coach will work with Ontario Hockey League (OHL) personnel.
- Each coach must be present for the entire duration of the camp and is required to stay in the same accommodations as camp staff and players.

Duties

- Coordinate and conduct all on and off ice training sessions in conjunction with team staff
- Coach team in all games and practices
- Assist with the supervision of players
- Assist with the creation and enforcement of team rules
- May be required to complete a player assessment for each team member

Qualifications

- Strong hockey background in coaching
- Ability to work well with other personnel including coaches, trainers and support staff
- Must have strong interpersonal skills in order to communicate with staff, coaches, players, parents and medical personnel
- Must be NCCP Certified
- Must have coached a team within the OHF in 2008-09 or be coaching a team within the OHF in 2009-10
- Must be Speak Out Certified

All interested applicants are required to submit their application form online by February 15, 2009.
