Trainer Job Description

The Ontario Hockey Federation (OHF) is now accepting applications for training staff positions at the 2009 OHF/OHL Under-16 Program of Excellence.

- There are six positions available at each camp (one per team).
- Each trainer must be present for the entire duration of the camp and is required to stay in the same accommodations as camp staff and players.

Equipment Duties

- Assist with coordination and distribution of team apparel including jerseys, socks, t-shirts & shorts
- Control distribution of team supplies
- Complete skate sharpening as necessary
- Attend to team laundry
- Arrange equipment and water bottles on team bench
- Attend to players' equipment needs during practices and games
- Organize the team dressing room

Medical Duties

- Administer treatment to players in need
- Keep records of all treatments
- Conduct pre-stretching and post-stretching sessions as necessary
- Assist with determining equipment and supply needs
- Administer first aid during practices, games, and other times as necessary
- Report injuries to medical personnel

Qualifications

- Must be HTCP certified
- Must be a trainer for a team within the OHF in 2008-09
- Must be Speak Out Certified
- Strong minor hockey background
- Must have strong interpersonal skills in order to communicate with staff, coaches, players, parents and medical personnel
